- 1~pack of 3 subject dividers (labeled: NOTES/CLASSWORK, HOMEWORK, EXTRA PAPER.)

Reading

- 1~pack of graph paper (with holes already punched for binder)
- 4~packs of wide ruled loose leaf paper—to be replenished as needed (Only put 1 pack in the math binder.)
- 1~plastic pocket folder, no prongs (Please label with student's name in the top right corner.)
